### Greetings from the Choir,

This week's anthem is **Jesus Loves Me.** This was originally written as a poem by Anna B. Warner. She wrote this poem to comfort a dying child. Later, William B. Bradbury set it to music and added the chorus part, "Yes Jesus, loves me." The original poem has 4 verses. As a child, I recall learning 3 of those verses. My mother directed our Junior Choir at Our Redeemer Lutheran Church in La Crosse. We would have to memorize our songs and sing for the congregation. So, <u>Jesus Loves Me</u> was one of those songs, etched in my memory, and giving me comfort throughout my years.

- 1. Jesus loves me—this I know, For the Bible tells me so: Little ones to him belong, —They are weak, but he is strong.
- 2. Jesus loves me—he who died, Heaven's gate to open wide; He will wash away my sin, Let his little child come in.
- 3. Jesus loves me—loves me still, Though I'm very weak and ill; From his shining throne on high, Comes to watch me where I lie.
- 4. Jesus loves me—he will stay, Close beside me all the way. Then his little child will take, Up to heaven for his dear sake

Our choir's version is an a cappella piece, written in 4-part harmony. This version has some very modern sounding chords but keeps the essence of the song intact. The anthem incorporates the first verse and the final verse. Bradbury changed the ending verse to: Jesus loves me. He will stay close beside me, all the way. If I love him when I die, He will take me home on high. My own family is facing an imminent death of a loved one, and yet we gather and are finding joy in all the love we have shared through the years. I'll end with a line from the 2nd reading of this Sunday's scripture: 1 Corinthians 13:1-13 13 And now faith, hope, and love abide, these three; and the greatest of these is love. This week, may you find comfort, faith, hope, and love.
